

## Dates to Remember

- The pool is open from **Memorial Day weekend (May 27)** to **Labor Day weekend (September 4)**, but this season, the pool will remain open on the weekends (Saturday and Sunday) during the **month of September**, *dependent upon weather and staff availability*.
- On the **weekdays** from May 30 to June 12, the pool is open 4 pm to 7 pm until school is released for the summer.
- The pool will have regular operating hours on July 4 (11 am – 7 pm).
- The **Woodstock Dolphins Swim Team** practices every evening, Monday through Thursday, from May 30 through July 5 from 7-9 pm at the pool. As noted above, the pool will have regular operating hours on July 4 (11 am – 7 pm).
- The pool will be closing at 5 pm on June 20 and on June 29 for swim meets.
- During the week of the **Shenandoah County Fair** (Aug 25 – Sept 2), the pool will be closing at 5 pm.

### Pool Parties/Pool Shelter Reservation:

The pool can be rented from 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Pool party rental is \$175.

The small, covered shelter within the pool area can be reserved for small birthday parties or other celebrations during pool hours. Pool shelter rental is \$25.

## 2017 SUMMER POOL SEASON INFORMATION

- In addition to cash and checks, we also accept **debit/credit cards** – both for admission to the pool (including season passes!) and for concession stand items.
- We will be opening on the weekends (Saturday and Sunday) during the month of September for the 2017 pool season.
- We are offering a discounted season pass rate for 2017 given the shortened summer season impacting many school age children and their families.
- The Town of Woodstock follows the Department of Social Services guidelines regarding adult supervision of young children at the pool as noted in the table below. Although seasonal employees act as first responders in the case of an accident, children shall still be supervised by a responsible party.

### Child Supervision Guidelines

Age 0-9	Should not be left unsupervised
Age 10-12	Should not be left unsupervised for more than 3 hours
Age 13-18	May be left alone for longer than 3 hours
